10 Cabins all with lower berths. Cabins **Dolphin** (4 in total) is located on upper deck and offers 4 twin beds that can be modified in double bed upon request. Cabins **Booby** (in total 2) offer double bed. Cabins **Iguana** are located on lower deck and offer only twin beds. All cabins have private facilities, individually controlled air conditioning, a small desk and sofa. The Dolphin and Booby cabins feature large windows which can not be opened. The Iguana cabins offer small windows (portholes) that cannot be opened as well .



**FACILITIES:**

Dining room, spacious sun deck, Library, bar, games room, laundry service



**SNORKEL EQUIPMENT:** Masks and fins available aboard the yacht free of use during the cruise.

**Wet suit:** Wet suits are available for passengers to use during the cruise at no additional charge. . Passengers who would like to reserve a wet suite in their size prior to the cruise may do so for a charge of \$25 for 7 nights.
